



34th Sanremo Historic Rally. Lucky shining in the Saturday morning

SANREMO (IM), 13 April – Change the day, change the special stages, but the music doesn't change. The three SS on Saturday morning are unequivocally for Lucky-Pons, Lancia Delta 16V, who manage to acquire a significant advantage of 27 "9 against Lucio Da Zanche and Daniele De Luis, Porsche 911, who confirm their second place in the race, even if the morning proposed other leading players. Starting with Davide Negri-Roberto Coppa able to take a second time overall in their 911 RS both on SS Testico and Colle d'Oggia SS, settling authoritatively on the third step of the podium and getting closer to the top of the Second Regrouping behind Marco Bertinotti-Andrea Rondi also in a same Porsche. Fifth place for Angelo Lombardo-Giuseppe Livecchi in their Porsche 911 SC consolidating their advantage in the Third Regrouping ahead of the Stratos of Tony Fassina-Marco Verdelli who in the stages of this morning improve their pace, as they said yesterday evening when they've climbed the classification till the sixth place overall, ahead of "Zippo"-Nicola Arena, that seemingly solved the problems they've had yesterday on their Audi Quattro.

The coup de théâtre of the morning came from the withdrawal of Totò Riolo-Gianfranco Rappa, who in an attempt to catch up yesterday went off road with their Subaru Legacy on the Testico special, the first of the day.
